

Californians and Divorce

Final Report September 6, 2016



The Study

These findings are based on a non-probability online sample of data collected from August 24 – September 3, 2016. A sample of over 650 California residents aged 25-55 were surveyed. The margin of error for this study is plus or minus 3.85 percentage points.

Avvo conducts periodic studies of topics at the intersection of lifestyle and the law to better understand the issues facing individuals engaging with attorneys and the legal system. Given that divorce and family law are two of the largest and most routine legal actions taken in the United States, Avvo strives to uncover American attitudes and behaviors of Americans regarding marriage and divorce.









Married couples in CA are more likely to believe in ever-after and to blame divorce on the couple








believe that people who get divorced don't try hard enough to make the marriage work







Men are more likely to see divorce as a failure; women more likely to see it as an opportunity










Married Californians are less likely to see divorce as an opportunity for something better

37% of unmarried



Most Californians can imagine divorce being OK for the kids








Men are more likely than women to see divorce as bad for the kids




believe it's better for children to see their parents divorced and happy than together and unhappy





Married couples in CA are more likely to think divorce can harm the kids
















Younger Californians are more hesitant about dating people who are divorced






